This course is a statement of the standards to be achieved to gain a FETAC credit in Sports Stadium Stewarding at Level 5.

It is designed to equip learners with the knowledge, skills and competence to act as a steward in a sports stadium in Ireland.

New and existing Stewards in the Sport and Leisure Industry of Ireland.

Entry Requirements

Learners wishing to do this course, should hold at least a level 4 certificate, leaving Certificate or equivalent Qualifications and/or relevant life / work experiences

Qualification

This Module is certified by FETAC, through Aras Rualach and is accredited at level 5 recognised under the National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ).

- *Contingency Planning*

Duration

The duration of the programme is 3-5 days with additional self directed learning.
