



Tiger Kidnap Awareness

In recent years the police have been working closely with financial institutions and cash in transit companies to prevent tiger kidnaps from taking place and to protect those people who may be most vulnerable to this kind of criminality. Significant steps have been taken to minimise the amount of cash accessible by employees and to improve security systems.

Current analysis indicates that the steps that the police have taken with the financial sector may have a displacement effect, particularly in the run up to a busy period. A number of retailers and members of the licensed trade have already been victims of tiger kidnaps and we might anticipate that criminals will again focus their attention on such businesses as they try to get access to cash. In order for you to be protected from this risk it is essential that you make yourself aware of it with this training course.

The aim of this course is to raise awareness of tiger kidnap and how it impacts on both the individual employee and organisation as a whole.

Any employee or employer who feels that they are at risk from becoming a target for a tiger kidnap, particular if their employment involves handling large amounts of cash or valuables.
